Net Script
Version 1-9-2011

At 8:59 PM, enter your repeater NET START control codes.

Good evening and welcome to the Polk County Amateur Radio Associations Monday Night ARES/RACES and General Check In Net. This is (CALL SIGN) and my name is (YOUR NAME). I am located in (YOUR QTH) and I will be your net control. This net meets every Monday evening at 9:00 PM local time. We use the club repeater, N9XH located near Balsam Lake, Wisconsin. The repeater requires a PL TONE of 110.9 Hz. Our alternate simplex frequency is 145.56 Megahertz should the repeater fail for any reason. This is (CALL SIGN) (Break)

Is there any Emergency or Priority traffic? (Break) Note: Immediately handle any emergency or priority traffic!

The Polk County Amateur Radio Association holds its membership meeting on the 2nd Saturday of each month. Many of us meet for breakfast at 8am at a local restaurant. Our meeting starts at 9 am and is held at the Polk County Government Center. Our next meeting is on (Saturday, MONTH, DATE). Do we have any announcements tonight? If so, please come now. (Break) Handle any incoming announcements.

Do we have any mobile, short on time or in and out stations that would like to check in if so please come now. (Break) Handle any short-time check-ins. They will not be included in the “go-around.”

Thank you. This is (CALL SIGN). Let’s start the check-in portion of our net. Everyone is invited to check-in. Please provide your call sign phonetically, your name, and your QTH.

(Note: Take a few calls until there is a pause)

Ok, thank you. (List the calls you heard)

Let’s continue, again, please list your call, your name, and your QTH.

(Note: Continue taking check ins and acknowledging them until there appears not to be any more.)

(The Net Control now goes down through the list of check ins for the “go-around”, calling each by call and name, and informally asks what they’ve been up and how they are doing.)

(Once your list is complete, be sure to ask again if there are any additional check ins for those who got to the net late.) (Be sure you ID every 10 minutes!)

I want to thank everyone for checking in tonight. We had a total of (NUMBER OF CHECK-INS). Are there any final comments for the net? If so please come now? (Break) Handle any last minute comments.

That concludes the Polk County Amateur Radio Association’s Monday Night ARES/RACES and General check in net. This is (YOUR NAME, YOUR CALL) returning the N9XH repeater back to normal amateur use.

Enter the NET STOP control codes.
