(Identify your station at the start of the net; if you're using the Net On code enter it at this time and wait for the repeater to announce the start of the "PCARA Monday night net.")

Good evening and welcome to the Polk County Amateur Radio Association's Monday night ARES/RACES and general check-in net. This net is open to anyone interested in ARES, RACES, SKYWARN, or support of Emergency or Disaster Communications and General Amateur Radio Communications. (Do a last call for check ins, if no more check ins, repeat any traffic or info that needs to be reminded or repeated).

(Remember to identify your station every 10 minutes if the Net runs long.)
